25% of Americans have a disability, making it today's largest minority population. Yet far too often, their important and varied stories go untold ... until now! Supported by some of Hollywood's biggest names, the [Easterseals Disability Film Challenge: Home Edition 2.0](#) addresses this under-representation by giving filmmakers the platform to collaborate and tell unique stories to help change the way the world defines and views disability. Judged by a noted and diverse group of entertainment industry talent, films are not required to include disability in the storyline, but teams must include at least one person with a disability in front of or behind the camera.

Finalists will be announced April 29. Winners, announced at a virtual event on May 6, are awarded industry mentorships; the opportunity to screen their film at numerous Academy Award-Qualifying festivals, including the Heartland Film Festival, HollyShorts Film Festival and NewFilmmakers LA; and other prizes, including \$1,500 grants provided by NBCUniversal, Dell Technologies Laptop, a one-year subscription to Adobe Creative Cloud, one-year complimentary IMDbPro membership, winning film highlighted in a video playlist on the homepage of IMDb, screenings at numerous Academy Award-qualifying festivals, a one-year membership to Film Independent, and mentorship meetings with entertainment industry executives and talent.
